INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the resolutions to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting for (a) the granting to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate; (b) the granting to the Directors the General Mandate; (c) the extension of the General Mandate by adding to it the aggregate number of the issued Shares repurchased under the Repurchase Mandate; and (d) the re-election of Directors.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

GENERAL MANDATES TO REPURCHASE SECURITIES AND TO ISSUE NEW SECURITIES

General mandate to repurchase shares

At the Annual General Meeting, an ordinary resolution will be proposed to the Shareholders that the Directors be granted the Repurchase Mandate. Under the Repurchase Mandate, the maximum number of Shares that the Company may repurchase shall not exceed 10% of the issued and fully paid up share capital of the Company as at the date of passing of the resolution. The Company's authority is restricted to repurchase Shares of the Company on the market in accordance with the Listing Rules. The mandate allows the Company to make repurchases only during the period ending on the earliest of the date of the next annual general meeting of the Company, the date by which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required to be held by the Articles or any applicable law of the Cayman Islands or the date upon which such authority is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders at a general meeting of the Company.

In accordance with the Listing Rules, an explanatory statement is set out in Appendix I of this circular to provide you with requisite information reasonably necessary to enable you to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the proposed ordinary resolution for the grant of the Repurchase Mandate at the Annual General Meeting.

General mandate to issue new shares

At the Annual General Meeting, a resolution will also be proposed to the Shareholders that the Directors be granted the General Mandate in order to ensure flexibility and discretion to the Directors to issue new shares. The General Mandate will represent up to 20% of the aggregate nominal amount of the issued share capital of the Company as at the date of passing of the resolution. Based on 7,441,355,450 Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date and assuming no further Shares will be issued or repurchased prior to the date of the Annual General Meeting, the Directors will be authorised to issue 1,488,271,090 Shares pursuant to the new general mandate.

Subject to the passing of the aforesaid ordinary resolutions of the Repurchase Mandate and the General Mandate, an ordinary resolution will also be proposed to the Shareholders to authorise the Directors to issue Shares in an amount not exceeding the aggregate nominal amount of the Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate.

RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Pursuant to Article 116 of the Company's Articles of Association, at each annual general meeting of the Company, one-third of the Directors for the time being or, if their number is not three or a multiple of three, then the number nearest to but not less than one-third, shall retire from office by rotation provided that each Director (including those appointed for a specific term) shall be subject to retirement by rotation at least once every three years at the annual general meeting, provided always that any Director appointed pursuant to Article 119 or Article 122(a) shall not be taken into account in determining the Directors who are to retire by rotation at such meeting. A retiring director shall retain office until the close of the meeting at which he retires, and shall be eligible for re-election thereat.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

Pursuant to Article 99 of the Company's Articles of Association, the Board shall have power from time to time and at any time to appoint any person as a Director either to fill a casual vacancy or as an addition to the Board. Any Director so appointed shall hold office only until the next following general meeting of the Company (in the case of filling a casual vacancy) or the next following annual general meeting of the Company (in the case of an addition to their number) and shall then be eligible for re-election at that meeting provided that any Director who so retires shall not be taken into account in determining the number of Directors who are to retire at such meeting by rotation pursuant to Article 116.

Pursuant to Article 116 of the Company's Articles of Association, Mr. Li Shu Fu, Mr. Gui Sheng Yue, Ms. Wei Mei, Mr. Wang Yang, Mr. Song Lin and Mr. Lee Cheuk Yin, Dannis shall retire by rotation and being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election at the Annual General Meeting.

The biographical details of the Directors proposed to be re-elected are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

CONTINUOUS APPOINTMENT OF AN INDEPENDENT NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SERVING MORE THAN 9 YEARS

According to paragraph A.4.3 of Appendix 14 to the Listing Rules, serving a company for more than 9 years could be relevant to the determination of a non-executive director's independence. If an independent non-executive director serves more than 9 years, any further appointment of such independent non-executive director should be subject to a separate resolution to be approved by shareholders.

Mr. Lee Cheuk Yin, Dannis has served as an Independent Non-executive Director since 28 June 2002 and he would serve the Company for more than 9 years from 28 June 2011 onwards. Nonetheless, the Company has received from Mr. Lee Cheuk Yin, Dannis a confirmation on independence pursuant to Rule 3.13 of the Listing Rules. Taking into account his independent status in the Board in the past years, and that he does not hold any executive functions or is not involved in the day-to-day management of the Company, the Directors consider Mr. Lee Cheuk Yin, Dannis to be independent under the Listing Rules despite the fact that if successfully re-elected in the forthcoming Annual General Meeting, he would have served the Company for more than 9 years from 28 June 2011 onwards.

Accordingly, the Directors would like to seek from the Shareholder an approval for the continuous appointment of Mr. Lee Cheuk Yin, Dannis as an Independent Non-executive Director at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting.

APPENDIX I EXPLANATORY STATEMENT FOR THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

This Appendix contains the particulars required by the Listing Rules to be included in an explanatory statement to enable the Shareholders to make an informed view on whether to vote for or against the resolution to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting in relation to the Repurchase Mandate.

LISTING RULES

The Listing Rules permit companies whose primary listings are on the Stock Exchange to repurchase their own shares on the Stock Exchange subject to certain restrictions, the most important of which are summarised below:

(a) Shareholders' approval

All proposed repurchases of shares on the Stock Exchange by a company with its primary listing on the Stock Exchange must be approved in advance by an ordinary resolution, either by way of a general mandate or by specific approval.

(b) Source of funds

Repurchases of shares must be funded entirely from the company's available cashflow or working capital facilities and will be made out of funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with the company's memorandum and articles of association and the laws of the Cayman Islands.

REASONS FOR SHARES REPURCHASE

The Directors believe that it is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole to continue to have a general authority from the Shareholders to enable the Directors to repurchase Shares of the Company on the market. Whilst it is not possible to anticipate in advance any specific circumstance in which the Directors might think it appropriate to repurchase Shares, they believe that an ability to do so would give the Company additional flexibility that would be beneficial to the Company and its Shareholders as such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at that time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share. Shareholders can be assured that the Directors will only make such repurchases in circumstances where they consider them to be in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 7,441,355,450 Shares. Subject to the passing of the resolution granting the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company will be allowed to repurchase a maximum of 744,135,545 Shares, being 10% of the issued share capital of the Company, during the period ending on the earlier of the conclusion of the next

annual general meeting of the Company or the date by which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required to be held by law or the date upon which such authority is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in general meeting.

FUNDING OF REPURCHASE

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with the memorandum and articles of association of the Company and the laws of the Cayman Islands. It is envisaged that the funds required for any repurchase would be derived from the capital paid up on the Shares being repurchased and from the distributable profits of the Company.

The Directors consider that there might be a material adverse effect on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited accounts contained in the most recent published annual report of the Company for the financial year ended 31 December 2010) in the event that the proposed share repurchases were to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. The Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing level of the Company which in the opinion of the Directors is from time to time appropriate for the Company.

DISCLOSURE OF INTERESTS

None of the Directors, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, nor any of their respective associates has any present intention in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders to sell any Shares to the Company.

No connected person has notified the Company that he/she has a present intention to sell Shares to the Company or its subsidiaries, or has undertaken not to do so, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

UNDERTAKING OF THE DIRECTORS

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

EFFECT OF THE TAKEOVERS CODE

If, on the exercise of the right to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. Accordingly, a Shareholder, or group of Shareholders acting in concert could, depending on the level of increase of the shareholding interest, obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, to the best knowledge of the Company, Mr. Li Shu Fu, who is the controlling shareholder of the Company through his interest in Proper Glory Holding Inc. ("Proper Glory") (Note 1) and parties acting in concert with it, is interested in 3,751,159,000 Shares, representing approximately 50.41% of the issued share capital of the Company. In the event that the Directors exercise the Repurchase Mandate in full to repurchase Shares which is proposed to be granted under the Repurchase Mandate, the shareholding interest of Mr. Li Shu Fu, together with parties presumed to be acting in concert with him, in the Company would increase to approximately 56.01%, such an increase will not give rise to an obligation to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code. The Directors are not aware of any consequences which would arise under the Takeovers Code as a result of any repurchases to be made under the Repurchase Mandate.

Note 1: Proper Glory is a private company incorporated in the British Virgin Islands and is beneficially wholly-owned by Mr. Li Shu Fu and his associate.
